

BOURBON TOWN PUBLIC HEARING & SPECIAL MEETING

September 24, 2013

The Public Hearing for the 2014 Budget was opened by President Les McFarland. No patrons were present and therefore, McFarland moved to close the public hearing with a second from Member Wattenbarger and it passed 3-0.

A special meeting of the Town Council for Bourbon, Indiana was held immediately following the public hearing in the Council Chambers with all Council Members, Larry Wattenbarger, Philip Hanley, Les McFarland, and Clerk-Treasurer Kimberly Berger present in person.

Member Wattenbarger moved to pass a resolution to borrow \$190,000.00 from the First State Bank to fund the Metheny Ditch Lift Station. A second came from Member Hanley and the resolution passed 3-0.


Clerk Treasurer Berger informed the Council that the First State Bank of Bourbon offered to allow the Town to place a Horse Parking area in a lot owned by them. The Council was not receptive to the idea, since the Town Employees would need to keep it clean. She also informed them that she had spoke to Greg Elkins owner of the lot at Main and Center Streets. Elkins stated that they are asking \$25,000.00 for the lot. The Council decided to offer \$15,000.00 for the lot. Berger stated that she would get in touch with them and report back.

Berger also asked the Council to set a date to meet with the employees to discuss wage and benefits for 2014. Being no other business to come before the Council, meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
